AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCES 2006-011 AND 2006-02 REGARDING PETTY CASH AND ESTABLISHING INITIAL MONIES FOR BILLING CLERK DRAWERS FOR THE TOWN OF SELLERSBURG, INDIANA

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2 *et seq.*, this Town Council of Sellersburg, Indiana (this "Council") is the town legislative body and the President of the town council is the town executive; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2-9, the legislative body may adopt ordinances and resolutions for the performance of functions of the town; and,

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance 2006-011 An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2006-002, An Ordinance Establishing A Petty Cash Fund For The Sellersburg Department of Municipal Works; and,

WHEREAS, from time to time this Council desires to amend or repeal its ordinances; and, WHEREAS, this Council now wishes to repeal Ordinance 2006-011, which established petty cash for certain departments of the Town of Sellersburg and establish an initial amount of monies for billing clerks for the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by this Town Council of Sellersburg, Indiana as follows:

- 1. Ordinances 2006-011 and 2006-02 establishing petty cash for the Town of Sellersburg are hereby repealed.
- 2. Billing clerks for the Town of Sellersburg shall have an initial daily balance of \$150 dollars per drawer and shall follow the laws of Indiana and the best practice approaches set forth by the Indiana State Board of Accounts in processing and accounting for Town funds.
