ORDINANCE NO. 2023 – OR – 022

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC CONTROL FROM THE INTERSECTION OF ADAMS CREEK DRIVE AND DORA DRIVE TO THE BACK OF THE CUL-DE-SAC AT THE END OF ADAMS CREEK.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2 *et seq.*, this Town Council of Sellersburg, Indiana (this “Council”) is the town legislative and fiscal bodies for Sellersburg, Indiana (the “Town”) and the President of this Council is the town executive; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2-9, the legislative body may adopt ordinances and resolutions for the performance of the functions of the Town; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 9-21-1-2, a local authority may adopt by ordinance additional traffic regulations with respect to highways under the authority’s jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 9-21-1-3, a local authority may regulate speed limits and traffic controls with respect to highways under the authority’s jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, this Council has identified a public safety issue specifically related to the intersection of Adams Creek Drive and Dora Drive to the back of the cul-de-sac at the end of Adams Creek Drive; and,

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2023, during a normal town board meeting, where the public was invited to attend and participate, it was discovered that school buses could not safely drive down said stretch of road in order to pick up and drop off kids due to the extensive on street parking.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by this Town Council of Sellersburg, Indiana the following:

1. The intersection of Adams Creek Drive and Dora Drive to the back of the cul-de-sac at the end of Adams Creek Drive shall no longer allow for on-street parking. *(See Exhibit A attached hereto).*
2. The Town Manager shall cause to have the necessary signage installed notifying the public of said modification. The signage shall be installed within public right of way and per INDOT and town standards where appropriate.
3. Any vehicle found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be towed by the Sellersburg Police Department and at the expense of the owner.
4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Council.
