ORDINANCE NO. 2023 – OR – 025

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE TOWN OF SELLERSBURG, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2 *et seq.*, this Town Council of Sellersburg, Indiana (this “Council”) is the town legislative body and the President of the town council is the town executive; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ind. Code § 36-5-2-9, the legislative body may adopt ordinances and resolutions for the performance of the functions of the Town of Sellersburg, Indiana (the “Town”); and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate additional monies than was appropriated in the annual budget; and,

WHEREAS, this matter was considered at an open meeting to which the public were invited to participate; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Sellersburg, Indiana and for the expenses of the Town of Sellersburg, the following additional sums are hereby appropriated to the funds referenced below and for the purposes specified therein, subject to the laws governing same:
