Hired Contractor Trimmed Limbs or Cut Down Trees

If you have hired a contractor to trim or cut down trees, the contractor is responsible for the removal of limbs and logs.

Pick-Up Not Available

Large amounts of yard waste or tree limbs equates to anything above normal yard waste as outlined within the Yard Waste Collection information listed on Sellersburg.org under the Street and Sanitation Department tab of the website.

Charge to be determined upon assessment and billed on next monthly invoice. Minimum Charge to be \$50.
Max charge not to exceed \$200.

Large Amounts of Yard Waste or Tree Limbs

The Sanitation Department reserves the right to assess a fee for special pickups of large amounts of yard waste such as large quantity of tree limbs. The Street and Sanitation supervisor will assess the debris and provide a price based on the labor and equipment that will be needed to complete the cleanup.

Items such as couches, mattresses, chairs, and stoves will be collected on Thursdays.

Large Items and Appliances (except exempt items) are picked up each Thursday except holidays.

Items such as TVs, Refrigerators, Tires, Old Paint, Chemicals, Oil, Fuel, etc. are **not included** within this service and must be disposed of in accordance with the law. No Charge

Large Amounts of Trash

The Sanitation Department reserves the right to assess a fee for special pickups of large amounts of trash, such as from the cleaning out of a house, garage, or tearing down a wooden deck. The Street and Sanitation supervisor will assess the amount and provide a price based on the labor and equipment that will be needed to complete the cleanup.

Charge to be determined upon assessment and billed on next monthly invoice. Minimum Charge to be \$50.
Max charge not to exceed \$500.
